

St. Seraphim Camper Rules

(These rules are posted in the mess hall, and are printed here for you to become familiar with them.)

1. All Campers will respect each other with Christian respect at all times, therefore fighting, put-downs or other behavior harmful to others is not allowed at camp.

2. There will be no camper out of his or her campsite after curfew. No exceptions. Any camper caught outside of his or her campsite without a very good reason and an adult staff member's knowledge will be assigned a duty or risk expulsion from camp.

3. No electronic devices will be allowed for campers - no radios, game machines, televisions, **cell phones**, iPods, night vision goggles, etc. **Cell phones may be kept in the camp office and used with permission only.** The only battery operated devices permitted are flashlights and cameras.

4. Any unapproved electronic devices will be confiscated and kept in the camp office, tagged with the owner's name and address. The camp is not responsible for any such devices, but an effort will be made to return the device to the parent of the camper.

5. All property must be respected: no graffiti and no destructive raiding.

6. Campers in inappropriate clothing will need to borrow from fellow campers or reuse appropriate clothing:

Girls:

- no spaghetti strap shirts will be allowed without a coverup shirt
- Shorts must be of a modest length
- No low cut tops
- Swimsuits must be modest 1-piece - no cutouts
- No midriff shirts

Boys:

- Must wear a shirt at all times - with the exception of swimming in the pool or river

7. Campers must have a "buddy" with them at all times. No campers should be away from their group alone.

8. It is mandatory that campers participate in scheduled activities unless there is a legitimate reason, to be determined by the Camp Director, for them not to.

9. The following are forbidden from camp grounds, **possession of which will result in immediate contact of parents and dismissal from camp:** alcohol, drugs, tobacco, firearms or other weapons, and any flammable substances.
